The Department of Public Works and Highways, Agusan del Sur 2nd District Engineering Office, Karaos, San Francisco, Agusan del Sur, through the FY 2025 GENERAL APPROPRIATIONS ACT (GAA) intends to apply the sum of **Sixty-One Million Eight Hundred Eighty Five Thousand Four Hundred Fifty Pesos Only (Php 61,885,450.00)** being the total Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) to payments under the contract for the following projects:

2. The Department of Public Works and Highways, Agusan del Sur 2nd District Engineering Office, Karaos, San Francisco, Agusan del Sur now invites bids for the aforementioned project. Bidders should have completed a contract similar to the Project. The description of an eligible bidder is contained in the Bidding Documents, particularly, in Section II (Instructions to Bidders).

3. Prospective Bidders should be (1) registered with and classified by the Philippine Contractors Accreditation Board (PCAB) with PCAB LICENSE Size Range of at least MEDIUM 'A' for Contract ID No. 25NC0040 Re-Ad.

Contractors/applicants who wish to participate in this bidding are encouraged to enroll in the DPWH Civil Works Application (CWA) at the DPWH Procurement Service (PrS), 5th Floor, DPWH Bldg., Bonifacio Drive, Port Area, Manila, while those already enrolled shall keep their records current and updated. The Contractor's eligibility to bid on the project will be determined using the DPWH Contractor Profile Eligibility Process (CPEP) and subject to further post-qualification. Loss Rate are attributed to the following reasons:

- a. The over/under-recoveries in the System were caused by the over/under-recover Generation Costs as well as Transmis which are major components of the For computation of System Loss Rate as prov ERC Resolution No. 16, Series of 2009.
- b. In calculating the implemented rate, the System Loss is computed monthly bas running data from the previous 12-month including both kWh purchased and kWh data is then used to determine the System gross-up factor on a monthly basis. In contrast, the calculation of the recov involves determining the Annualized Sy once per year, using actual monthly data year. This annualized figure is then used as the System Loss for the gross-up factor for year.
